HIGH SPEED ALI quickly clear and angled in, was rated on a solid pace along the inside, drew off into the stretch when roused and stayed clear late. TRUELY WICKED within striking distance three wide, finished willingly to be slowly getting to the winner late. PRINCESS LANGFUHR close up from the outset, saved ground on the turn and lacked a late bid. MINER'S MEADOW outrun early, made a late gain. ENJOYABLE forced the pace in the three path, drifted wide late on the turn and tired. BELLE'S BLAZE close up along the inside, tired. RAVISHING RUBY within striking distance off the inside, faded.
