SLAMMIN' LIL well placed early, angled out on the backstretch, challenged after a half and drew off late under steady urging. RADIANTLY close up from the start, took over before a half, responded willingly when challenged after a half, held on well to inside the final furlong and tired. SASSY BELLE six wide early, dropped back and was outrun for a half, made a run five wide on the second turn but lacked a late bid. MARY SCOTT far back early, angled out five wide late on the second turn when rallying but was no real threat. INDIAN FIGHT within striking distance three wide, faded. PRADO'S LASS lost her footing at the start, raced four wide into the first turn, made a mild move before a half but faded after six furlongs. CLASSIC HABIT forwardly placed along the inside, faded. GOOD TALK was no factor. LIN MI LIN sprinted clear, set the early pace along the inside and stopped. THE FUSE IS LIT five wide early, stopped.
