**Footnotes**

OLIVE CAN rushed to the lead along the inside, set the pace off the inside, drew off in upper stretch when roused and was not menaced while under steady handling. JENIIGOTYOURNUMBER outrun early along the inside, angled out leaving the turn but lodged only a mild bid for the place. OUT OF MY MIND within striking distance early, raced five wide into the stretch and improved her position while no threat. LITTLE B'S ANGEL forced the pace five wide, held on well to midstretch and tired. CALL HER GRIMACE close up while in the four path and between rivals, tired. SMOKIN BAN lost her footing a bit at the start, recovered to race within striking distance, came six wide into the stretch and could not threaten. STICH'S PUBLICPICK close up along the inside, faded. SHE'S STUBBERN failed to menace along the inside. ROJA'S HERO was no factor. LITTLE MISS LUCY stumbled at the start, forced the pace three wide and gave way. LITTLE RED WAGON was outrun six wide.
