JEFF THE CLOCKER outrun early, advanced six wide on the second turn, caught the leaders with a furlong to go and drew clear under steady urging. SWINGING BERNIE forwardly placed off the inside, challenged on the second turn and held on for the place. DUBAI AFFAIR set the pace along the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired. SCARIFF ISLAND within striking distance three wide, lacked a rally. BORDEN BRAVE outrun for a half, raced six wide on the second turn and was no threat. WHEREAS DENTON within striking distance in the three path, gave way. BIRMAN four wide on the first turn, moved out a path on the second turn and faded in the drive. WATERSHED EVENT was outrun. CALIFORNIA LION close up while off the inside, stopped. AMANOFHISWORD prominent four wide, stopped.
