MICHAELS PARK behind the leaders four wide, responded in the stretch and closed fast to be up in the final stride. PURELY BOY outrun early, commenced his rally along the inside with three furlongs to go, angled out for the drive and finished with good energy while drifting out in the final sixteenth. SETTOP bore in at the start, sprinted clear and drew off, set the pace off the inside, moved to the rail once in the stretch and faltered late. DESERT BAY reserved early, raced in the four path with three furlongs to go and made a good late gain. ST. ARMANDS outrun four wide, found his best stride too late. SULLY'S LANDING carried in at the start, was reserved for a half and made a late gain. GLOUCESTER BAY forwardly placed three wide, lacked the needed late bid. COMMANDEER close up in the three path, weakened. TIGER WOZ was outrun. BE A BIDDER was through early. BIG TRUMPET was no factor.
