**Footnotes**

FAMILY COVENANT within striking distance, angled in to be just off the inside on the turn, responded to pressure through the stretch and finished willingly between rivals to be up in time. MISS CHRIS forwardly placed, raced four wide into the turn then rallied willingly late but was outfinished. NORMA'S CASH CROP set the early pace outside, came in near the half mile marker tightening up inner rivals, responded when headed on the turn and held on gamely in the drive. JILTED PAYMASTER bumped at the start, raced within striking distance three wide but lacked a late bid. SHATTERPROOF in tight at the start, was reserved early, saved ground on the turn and had little left in the drive. FRENCH LADY drifted out at the start, bumped with DERBY PARTY several times late on the backstretch, alternated for the lead from the inside afterwards then weakened. MISS ROYAL DANCER bumped at the start, was unhurried early, raced five wide with three furlongs to go and was no real threat. DERBY PARTY close up while off the inside, was in tight near the half mile marker, bumped with FRENCH LADY several times late on the backstretch, recovered to race forwardly but tired in the drive. DOS'S HOSS was outrun. SHEZACART outsprinted early, raced four wide on the turn and was no factor. PATOOT'S SO RARE in tight in the initial furlong, was outrun. Following a stewards inquiry, NORMA'S CASH CROP was disqualified and placed eighth for interference on the backstretch.
