CRIMSON DANCER reserved off the inside while within striking distance, advanced inside on the second turn, angled out for the drive, wore down the leader and edged off late. OPENING DANCE set the pace along the inside, repulsed a bid by ANGELA MARJORIE after a half, increased her lead on the second turn and held on gamely to be second best. OUR LADY MEGAN forwardly placed four wide, made a run at the leader with a half mile to go, held on well to the stretch and tired. TAMBOS JAZZ DANCER close up while off the inside, gave way. LOST COMPOSER was no threat. PHONE JOAN well placed early, faded. ANGELA MARJORIE forced the early pace three wide, challenged in earnest with a half mile to to but stopped after five furlongs.
