**Footnotes**

VOLTAGE within striking distance, made a bold four wide move on the turn, challenged approaching the stretch then drew off under steady urging. LAST DAWN within striking distance three wide, came out six wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the place. OUT OF THE CRISIS reserved early off the inside, moved to the rail for the drive but had nothing left late. ENGLISH unhurried early, raced four wide on the turn and had no late bid. MOGAMBO JON forwardly placed along the inside, was angled out four wide leaving the turn and tired. SAMPSON outrun early, raced along the inside on the turn and was no threat. FIT TO PARTY prompted the pace between rivals, steadied in midstretch to avoid SEVEN ON DICE then faded. ROCK HOUND outrun early, raced five wide on the turn, swerved out in midstretch and was no threat. DARTH was outrun. LUCKY SWEEP prompted the pace three wide, dropped back into the stretch, clipped SEVEN ON DICE's heels in midstretch, bobbed then faded. AIR AFLEET outrun early, raced three wide on the turn, took up in midstretch to avoid LUCKY SWEEP then stopped. SEVEN ON DICE vied for the lead along the inside and broke down in midstretch.
