### Footnotes

IRONIC LADY vied for the lead off the inside, responded to vigorous handling in the stretch and proved narrowly best. EVE'S VALENTINE outrun early, made a good middle move, challenged the winner with a quarter mile to go but was outfinished. CIMPLY SAVIO outrun early off the inside, made a good gain on the second turn but lodged only a mild late bid. SUDLEY SPRINGS alternated for the lead along the inside and tired. BOOGIE MOTEL behind the leaders inside, moved out four wide midway through the second turn and weakened. CYBERTECH within striking distance off the inside, faded.
