



**Footnotes**

GOLDEN MARLIN in a bit tight after the start, recovered, made a quick move to a forward position in the opening quarter, challenged the leader once on the turn, shook off that one in midstretch and drew clear under mile handling. MISS MARY APPLES close up between rivals, steadied once in the turn when pressured from the outside, angled out to the four path recovering, advanced four wide into the stretch and closed fast late. PAMPERED PRINCESS forwardly placed three wide, moved in to the rail with three furlongs to go tightening up inner rivals, came off the rail for the drive but lodged only a mild late bid. WILDCAT ANNIE sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace off the inside and weakened late. ALMOST DISSUADED far back early, launched her rally off the inside on the turn and made a good late gain. IN CASE OF WIND within striking distance, raced four wide into the turn and lacked the needed late bid. ANYPLACE ANYTIME sluttish at the start, was outsprinted, raced four wide with three furlongs to go, came out five wide late on the turn and was no real threat. MISS DAKOTA close up from the start, angled down to the inside, took up with three furlongs to go when in tight then made no recovery.
