Footnotes

DIDYAGETITDONE attended the pace under a snug hold from between horses, swung six wide to launch his bid, closed with a rush and was up in the final strides. BLUE CHERRIES SPIN rushed to the lead along the inside, dueled through the opened half, shook clear entering the stretch, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. WON HAPPY BACHELOR was unhurried into stride, closed the gap through the turn, got through to make a bold bid but lacked the needed late response. ALDERSGATE was unhurried early, made a late rally circling seven wide but was left with too much to do. MOE MONEY prompted the pace between horses but weakened during the drive and gave way. MERRIMACK PAT chased the pace four wide to the stretch and faltered. TWILIGHT raced wide throughout and was never a factor. SPLISH rushed to contention five wide, but came up empty after a half and dropped out. HURRY MURRAY disputed the pace three wide from between horses for a half and stopped.
