Footnotes

CANYON COPPER tracked the pace in hand, came three wide to make his bid, reeled in the weakening LUCKY CHUCK and was inching away late. The latter tucked in the save ground, commenced an early move along the inside, took over midway through the second turn, opened clear with a quarter mile to run, stayed on well but was unable to resist the winner. CORNWHISKEY was allowed to settle, responded when roused with three furlongs to run, got through entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. OUR KING opened clear to set the pace, was collared with five-sixteenths to run and gave way. GRAND PIANO MAN was allowed to settle, came five wide and improved position through the lane. FOR MEN ONLY was unhurried five wide and passed only the tiring ones. SARKOZY settled in the second flight five wide and failed to respond. EDDIE SET GO was close up four wide for a half and dropped out. GREAT RISK was outrun.
