FOR FILLIES, THREE-YEARS-OLD. No nomination fee. \$200 to enter and \$200 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Thursday, January 19, 2006 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees). \$40,000 Guaranteed plus \$10,000 KTDF for KTDF eligibles only. Monies to be divided 62% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight : 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes allowed, 2 lbs.; two races other than maiden or claiming 4 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Preference to start will be given to Stakes winners, then those horses that have accumulated the highest career earnings. In addition no same owner entry may start to the exclusion of a single entry. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed Wednesday, January 11, 2006 with 31 Nominations.

MIGHTY MARTHA vied for the lead off the inside, angled well out in the strip for the drive and drew off under steady urging. ANNA DANA forwardly placed off the inside, moved out to the three path late on the turn bumped with MONEY CODE in midstretch then finished willingly to be up for the place. MONEY CODE outsprinted early raced near the rail on the turn, came out a bit once in the stretch, bumped with ANNA DANA in midstretch then lacked a late bid. SUMMER CYCLONE broke in the air, was far back for a half and made a good late gain. ALWAYS A STAR (IRE) forced the pace from the inside and tired in the drive. MILITARY CASH outrun early, raced six wide into the turn and was no threat. SKIP THE STORM lost her footing at the start, angled out, raced in the five path into the turn and could not menace. LADY INTELLECT prominent four wide, faded. HEAVENLY OIL seven wide into the turn, was outrun.
