### Footnotes

STONE EAGLE was obscured by fog in all but a few spots through the race, tracked the pace three wide into the first turn, was at the heels of the leader when in view, wore down ESPRESSO JOE inside the furlong marker and was all out to best SIR P. T. CHALONE through the drive. SIR P. T. CHALONE was away slowly, moved into contention along the inside through the first turn, kept on well through a long drive, got through entering the stretch but wasn't quite good enough. ESPRESSO JOE set the pace off of the inside, weakened between horses inside the furlong marker, gave way and settled for the show. RAGPICKER'S SAINT was allowed to settle, came three wide and improved position through the lane. ROCKET ZONE contended three wide through the second turn and faded. COLONEL POTTER was close up four wide for six furlongs and faded. NAVAJO PARK settled off of the inside and failed to respond. TRICKY WATERS was through early and distanced.
