CRASHING SANDSTORM close up four wide, challenged three wide before a half, stayed in that path on the second turn, drew clear into the stretch and held sway under pressure. WHISPERING HEAT steadied inside on the first turn, moved up four wide after a half, challenged approaching the stretch and held on gamely. MS. MARY MARIE close up while off the rail, lacked a late bid. SLYBECCA stumbled at the start, was outrun for a half, saved ground on the second turn and was no real threat. IRISH VISION alternated for the lead from the start, held on well to the stretch and tired. SLEEPWALKER forced the pace along the inside and gave way. GENERAL STEFFIE was outrun. ETERNAL SUNSHINE reserved early, made a good four wide middle move but gave way in the drive. MON CABO could not menace. B B CAT unprepared at the start, was in tight son after then was no factor.
