BABES stumbled at the start, rushed to the lead, set the pace near the rail, increased her lead into the stretch and stayed clear under steady urging. INTERESTING close up from the start, raced in the four path into the turn, could not keep pace with the winner after a half but finished willingly late for the place. NANCY'S P. T. within striking distance, raced six wide into the turn and lodged a mild late bid. HAYLEY GO BLUE reserved, made an inside move on the turn but had no late bid. SHINY DANCER forwardly placed from the start, raced five wide into the turn and weakened in the drive. SOUTHERN WAY angled in approaching the turn, raced off the rail when within striking distance and gave way. TAYLOR'S GIGGLE was no factor. SWEET ON BERTIE within striking distance, raced seven wide into the turn and stopped.
