STRIKE IMPACT close up four wide, challenged with a half mile to to and proved narrowly best under pressure. STAN THE TAP MAN vied for the lead off the inside, drifted out in upper stretch and held on gamely. GLOSS alternated for the lead three wide, was in tight in upper stretch when the runner up drifted out then weakened. SOLO CAT pulled early along the inside behind the leaders, challenged from the rail before a half, dropped back a bit on the second turn then lacked a late bid. RUNAWAY BANJO forwardly placed off the inside, had nothing left late. CONDITION RED within striking distance, raced five wide with three furlongs to go and tired. FOUL CLAIMS BY THE RIDER OF GLOSS AGAINST THE RIDER'S OF STRIKE IMPACT AND STAN THE TAP MAN WERE NOT ALLOWED.
