COALINGA sped clear to set the pace and safely led throughout. OUR GIRL ALICE settled in hand, ranged up five wide through the turn, failed to threaten the winner but kept on fairly well to hold the place. TWO STEPPIN' TANGO broke a step slow, was unhurried into stride, came five wide and was up between rivals to earn the show. TRIBECKY contended between horses three wide but lacked the needed late response. BANNER YEAR was hustled along four wide but went evenly through the drive. WEED OF WILDFLOWER was hustled along four wide, finished with a mild rally but failed to seriously threaten. QUEEN IMIDALA saved ground to no avail. ASIAN PROVERB was hustled along three wide, steadied between horses near the seven-sixteenths pole and showed little thereafter. ANDREA LOUISE was forwardly placed along the inside for a half and retreated. NATIVE KITTEN failed to respond. QUIET GIRL was close up between horses, but came up empty leaving the turn and dropped out. JACKIE'S WEDDING was shuffled back between rivals early and never recovered.
