MAX THE KNIFE stalked the pace three deep, launched a bold bid leaving the turn, gained command a furlong out and gradually edged clear. TAP N POINT prompted the pace three wide, drew even nearing the quarter pole, continued on well but was unable to match strides with the winner late. OLD RING rushed to the lead along the inside, set the pressured pace to the stretch but weakened in the drive. ONE FOR BISCUIT was away alertly and disputed the pace two wide, but faltered from between horses after a half and faded. ALMOST SUMMER was slow into stride and never a factor. HE CAN HE WILL saved ground to no avail. LEGGS AN LIGHTNING trailed.
