DRIVE THRU BLUES settled along the rail on the backstretch, angled out and split horses while in a bit tight approaching the stretch, rallied to collar SURE SPECIAL near the wire and prevailed while being ridden out. SURE SPECIAL vied for the lead outside of BEVIE'S PARTY on the first turn while in hand, went clear on the backstretch, had her rider lose the whip in upper stretch and was caught late. MORISOT trailed to the second turn, raced three wide around that bend, had a mild late rally without threatening. TRICKLE DOWN stalked the pace to the stretch before weakening. BEVIE'S PARTY vied for the lead along the rail around the first turn, dropped back after the first half mile.
