PROMISE ME A PRIZE reserved for a half, advanced five wide late on the second turn, caught the leaders in midstretch and drew clear under steady urging. GENTLE GRACE vied for the lead off the inside, saved ground on the second turn and held on for the place. INDIVIA forwardly placed challenged three wide on the second turn but weakened. GO DAWG stumbled at the start, raced in the four path on the first turn, made a good four wide middle move but tired in the drive. BROADBRUSH BEAUTY within striking distance off the inside, lacked a late bid. BOBBY'S BABE close up along the inside, tired. SWEET DIECISEIS forced the pace from the inside and gave way. BEPPIN prompted the pace three wide and faded. DEPUTY SAMMIE was outrun.
