DARING JULIE sprinted clear from the outside to set all pace, withstood a challenge after three quarters and responded well to pressure and drew clear under steady handling. REQUEST DENIED rated back early, raced three wide at the quarter pole with a strong bid into the stretch but flattened out in the drive. SINGING LAUR tracked leaders to the quarter pole, took up chase into the stretch but also flattened out when the real running began. GHAZI DUST no speed to the stretch, swung wide for the drive and moved up late while no real menace. FILLY OF SOUL raced evenly and lacked the late response needed in the stretch. HIGH STRIKE failed to menace. BID MADE chased winner for a half then retreated thereafter. MATTY FINE was through after a half. PAR GOLFER had a steady fade.
