KENTUCKY PEACHES reserved three wide, advanced five wide after a half, challenged late on the second turn, drew clear in midstretch and held sway late. CHICALELEE behind the leaders, moved up four wide after three furlongs, challenged with a half mile to go, battled to the stretch, could not stray with the winner in midstretch but was coming again late. SAILORS PASTTIME unhurried off the inside, made a good middle move but lodged only a mild late bid. THIS WAY HOME outrun early, made a good three wide middle move but could not sustain the bid. FONDA RONDA TWO was no factor. NOLA STAR alternated for the lead off the inside and faded. CUDDLE THE GLORY vied for the lead along the inside and stopped.
