Footnotes

WELL WHAT was unhurried into stride, settled toward the inside, closed the gap through the second turn, got through entering the stretch, shifted to the outside of NOBLE SAILOR for the final furlong and was up late. NOBLE SAILOR disputed the pace two wide, kept on well through a prolonged drive but was unable to resist the winner. PHROGPHLYER set the pressured pace along the inside, but flattened in the final furlong and faded. CARPENTER JACK broke slow, was allowed to settle, moved up off of the inside on the second turn, loomed a danger entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. CLEAR BOARD lunged at the start, settled in hand, ranged into contention four wide but came up empty after six furlongs. TRADE DEFICIT chased the pace four wide for a half and dropped out. FREE AFRICA pulled to contention along the inside, had the saddle slip, rushed the fore between horses, then had the jockey lose both irons, drifted out through the second turn and stopped thereafter.
