OPERATIVE ASSETS opened clear to set the pace, kept on and was all out to just last. BIOGIO'S GIFT broke slow, settled in hand, commenced a long drive four wide, kept on well but was unable to reach the winner. ALL SNUFFED UP was nearest the pace toward the inside, weakened during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. NOT AN ALTAR BOY broke slow, was allowed to settle, came five wide and improved position. RUN MARVIN RUN was allowed to settle, tucked in three wide but lacked a response when called upon. WYGUN settled six wide and was never a factor. SOLID RUSH was close up three wide, but came up empty on the second turn and dropped out. ALYEYE was through after a half. HOTNITESINMICHIGAN hopped start, bolted on the first turn, veered hard into the chute near the three-quarter pole and unseated his jockey.
