JELLY CABLE within striking distance, moved up three wide with three furlongs to go, angled to the rail entering the stretch, challenged from the inside with a furlong to go and drew clear. KITTEN'S HOUSE set the pace off the inside and held on to be second best. ROCHITTA forwardly placed four wide, stayed in that path on the second turn, held on well to the final furlong and tired. LEELAND close up along the inside, came off the rail late on the second turn, stayed on to the final furlong and tired. FLOWERMING within striking distance five wide, gave way in the final quarter. SHOPPED OUT outrun for a half, never threatened. ENHANCING reserved for a half, raced four wide on the second turn and could not menace. KEIAI TOKYO pressed the pace three wide and faded. BABY AT THE PARK outrun early five wide, never reached contention. GO KATE GO tired from her early efforts.
