Footnotes

ORIGINAL KITTEN contested the pace between horses, shook clear on the turn and widened. SPUN CLEAR prompted the pace four wide, was unable to match strides with the winner, but kept on well to prove best of the rest. CHAOTIC CAT disputed the pace three wide between horses, weakened during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. DEBONAIR DANCER was allowed to settle, swung six wide to make a mild rally but failed to threaten. TRANS CONTINENTAL vied for the lead along the inside, steadied inside the five-sixteenths pole and showed little thereafter. SUGAR SHENANIGAN'S chased the pace four wide, but faltered before going a half and retreated. HENRIETTA'S PRAYER broke slow, dropped far back and was never a factor. CAT'N MOUSE was through early.
