AMAZING SAINT reserved five wide, moved up six wide with three furlongs to go, challenged approaching the stretch and proved best under pressure. PISH POSH close up along the inside, challenged in earnest before a half, battled the remainder but was outfinished. LADY CHARLIE forced the early pace four wide, lost a bit of position before a half, stayed in the four path on the second turn and came again late. GRACE'S MIRACLE prominent six wide, moved in a bit on the backstretch, challenged on the second turn and held on gamely. SILVER SIERRA within striking distance six wide, moved to the five path on the second turn, reached a challenging position with a quarter mile to go but tired. ERASINGLY with the pace three wide, moved in a bit on the second turn after dropping back a bit then tired. LEMON CRUNCH prominent off the inside, gave way. GREY MIST failed to menace. RAJPUR ROAD alternated for the lead five wide, moved in to be off the inside on the second turn and faded in the drive.
