DOC LA POINTE within striking distance off the rail, moved to the inside leaving the turn, challenged in midstretch and proved narrowly best. S. S. RAZOR forced the pace three wide, angled in in upper stretch, responded when headed by the winner and held on gamely but was outfinished. SWEET TALKIN FELLA prompted the pace four wide and held on gamely. CHINCHILLA DAY angled out when reserved, raced three wide on the turn, came wider for the drive but lacked a late bid. HESMYTEMPTATION alternated for the lead off the inside and tired. MY CHAPERREL angled out early when within striking distance, raced five wide on the turn and could not menace. LEAD PLAYER lost his footing at the start and was outrun. TEXAS HOLDEM JOE was no threat.
