Footnotes

BACK TO ACK within striking distance off the inside, moved out a bit on the second turn, reeled in the leaders and proved best late under pressure. SEVEN DAY HOLIDAY closest to the pace three wide, challenged once in the stretch and held on gamely. POUND THE ROCK set the pace off the inside, battled into deep stretch and held on gamely. BIG MCCOOL five wide on the first turn when reserved, stayed in that path on the second turn and could not threaten. RIDGE CITY close up four wide, gave way in the drive. TRIP NORTH forwardly placed off the rail, saved ground on the second turn and faded. JUMP START NOW was outrun.
