Footnotes

SWEET EUPHORIA settled in hand, launched a bold bid five wide, struck the front with a furlong to run and gradually edged clear. LAST PRUNER contended between horses, came four wide to make her move from between rivals, loomed a danger but was unable to resist the winner. MISS FARK was unhurried into stride five wide, came seven wide to make a late rally and was along in time to earn the show. MILLION BELLS disputed the pace off of the inside, settled off of the lead after a half, came again entering the stretch but weakened during the drive and gave way. TRES COPY pulled along the inside, tugged her way to the fore after a half, opened clear on the second turn, but came up empty entering the stretch and faded. TRUST SLEW broke slowly and passed only her tiring rivals. CALLIE'S WRIGHT was unhurried into stride, made a middle move along the inside to close the gap, but was used up after six furlongs and dropped out. NINA NINA was fractious in the gate, broke slowly, rushed to contention between horses three wide, pressed the pace for a half and stopped.
