Footnotes

PROSPECTOR RUNNING reserved early, raced off the inside on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and closed fast late to be up in time. DIXIE DELIGHT vied for the early lead off the rail, took over on the turn but could not last. LUCKY CHEROKEE outrun early, came three wide into the stretch but lodged only a mild late bid. MARIAN'S BUBBLES within striking distance along the inside, weakened in the final furlong. THE BIG BLOND contested the early pace from the outside and tired. COMEDY OF ERRORS outrun early, found her best stride too late. INDIAN FAN bobbed early, recovered, bumped with STATUESQUE near the five furlong marker, recovered and raced behind the leaders three wide but tired in the drive. NAVIGATRIX was no factor. HOOKLINEANDSINKER unhurried early, raced five wide into the turn and was no threat. STATUESQUE bumped with INDIAN FAN near the five furlong marker, recovered to race within striking distance but faded in the drive. BINALONG DAY forwardly placed outside, faded. FEARLESS HING was outrun.
