CHANNEL VISION unhurried early, made a run four wide on the second turn, caught the leaders with a furlong to go and drew clear under steady urging. RECKLESS ABANDON vied for the lead along the inside and held on gamely in the stretch. FAIRY DUST forced the pace three wide, angled in a bit on the backstretch and tired in the final sixteenth. TEMPESTATINATEAPOT far back early, made a good gain off the inside on the second turn but had no late bid. AMBER CHARM with the leaders early between rivals, steadied once in the first turn, recovered to race within striking distance but tired. RUTHLESS ONE within striking distance four wide, faded. JEANIE'S TREAD reserved along the inside, was no factor. CEE CEE ROUGE vied for the early lead between rivals, stopped and was outdistanced.
