PLUMLAKE LADY closest to the pace off the inside, challenged when ready on the second turn, took over in upper stretch and stayed clear under steady urging. REGALE outsprinted early three wide, split rivals approaching the stretch when rallying, reached closest to the winner in upper stretch but had no late bid. FLY AWAY ANGEL unhurried four wide, moved to contention five wide late on the second turn but had nothing left late. UNTHINKABLE within striking distance three wide, moved out to the four path on the second turn, stayed on well to the stretch and gave way. PAD THE WALLET close up from the start, held on well to the stretch and faded. TRU ATTITUDE close up along the inside, gave way. STAVINSKY'S GAL set the pace along the inside, stayed on well to the stretch and faded.
