BAIL US OUT raced in traffic on the first turn, steadied near the half mile marker, waited behind rivals on the second turn, angled out for the drive and finished fast to be up in time. SOUPED UP FAST set the pace, raced off the inside on the second turn and was outfinished while drifting out late. WHERE'S MY SWIPER forwardly placed three wide, lacked a closing bid. COMMODORE'S ALLEY forwardly placed from the start, saved ground on the second turn and weakened. GRASS AFFAIR within striking distance four wide, lacked a rally. CAVALERO outrun for a half, raced in the four path on the second turn and never threatened. JOE MAC within reach of the lead while off the inside, faded. PRIZE N SHINE closest to the pace off the inside, gave way. JOE'S BIG TIME was no threat.
