FINDING PARADISE close up four wide, responded to urging in the stretch and closed well to be up in time. BIG ALBERT set the pace off the inside, increased his lead a bit into the stretch but was outfinished. NO RAIN NO RAINBOW broke in the air, was outrun early, advanced off the rail on the turn and made a late gain. BARRY DALE within striking distance six wide, tired. RICHWOOD SPEEDSTER closest to the pace in the three path, stayed on well to the stretch and faded. GRANDSUN drifted out after the start after being carried out a bit, raced forwardly five wide but gave way. CHARLIE'S RAINMAN bothered after the start, was reserved early, raced nine wide into the turn and was no threat. ROCKY BEAR was outrun. TALENT ON LOAN failed to menace while three wide. STORMS OF YANJI lost his footing at the start, bumped BEMINEONVALENTINE recovering, raced seven wide into the turn and faded. BEMINEONVALENTINE bumped at the start, was outrun.
