**Footnotes**

CHOCOLATE LICORICE behind the leaders off the rail, angled out on the backstretch, moved up four wide on the second turn to challenge, drew clear into the stretch and lasted late. DAZZLE HER within striking distance five wide, advanced in that path on the second turn and closed well. BRUSHFIREAIRYTALE outrun early six wide, raced in the six path with three furlongs to go and made a good late gain. GRACE'S MIRACLE closest to the pace three wide, gained a short lead on the second turn but weakened in the drive. EJAY outrun early four wide, made a late gain. SABRE'S SILHOUETTE unhurried off the inside, raced in the three path on the second turn and could not threaten. UNBRIDLED ALLURE broke slowly, angled out, raced five wide with three furlongs to go and was no factor. LATE within striking distance along the inside, tired in the drive. OCTOBER SONG within reach four wide, faded. INLOVEWITHLOVE sprinted clear, set a fast pace near the rail and stopped.
