ST. IVAN forced the pace off the inside, responded when roused in the stretch and drew clear late. OUTOFSITEOUTOFMIND alternated for the lead along the inside and held on gamely to be second best. GRACE'S DEVIL prompted the early pace four wide, dropped back a bit before a half, raced in the three path on the second turn and tired in the drive. KNOWS HOW TO ROCK behind the leaders off the rail, saved ground on the second turn and gave way. EYE FOR AN EYE within striking distance in the two path, faded. UNBRIDLED MAKER six wide early when outrun, moved in to the four path on the second turn and was no factor. CAMPTON seven wide early, raced five wide on the second turn and never menaced. GRACEAN was no threat. STREET SWAGGER a bit eager after a sluggish start, raced four wide on the first turn and faded after six furlongs. DOUG JUNIOR was outrun. ROB'S ROCK with the early pace five wide, moved in a bit for the second turn and stopped.
