KENTUCKY PEACHES vied for the lead off the rail, took over on the second turn, drew off into the stretch and was not menaced while kept to the task. MODEL'S MEMO within striking distance off the inside, lodged a mild late bid. EDITORS RANSOM prominent four wide, had little left late. LAST PRUNER close up, three wide, tired in the drive. BURL'S JUNIANA forced the pace from the inside and tired in the stretch. NEON LIPSTICK outrun off the inside, was no threat. CLASSIC EMILY was no factor along the inside. MINON tired while three wide. TIA RUFINA five wide early, was outrun.
