PELAGO settled in hand, launched a bold bid circling four wide, assumed command and quickly drew clear. RIDE AROUND SALLY broke a step slow, settled saving ground, got through and finished well to earn the place. PANA MEMORIES set the pressured pace toward the inside, weakened during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. RARELY broke slowly, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. VAGABON DIVA was hustled along five wide but lacked a response when called upon. SADDLE IRENA passed only the tiring ones. MUY MUY was forwardly placed three wide, but faltered between horses leaving the turn and faded. INVOKE prompted the pace between horses but stopped before going a half.
