BOLD NORTH rushed up along the inside, opened clear on the turn and widened through the drive. MR. CASUAL disputed the pace between horses, was unable to match strides with the winner, but stayed on well to hold the place. AUTUMN STAR was allowed to settle, came four wide and finished with a mild rally to earn the show. GOOD BUT WICKED stumbled at the start, dropped well back, finished with a belated gain but was never a factor. MR. WATT vied for the lead three wide for a half and faded. CASTLE STORM saved ground to no avail. LARRYS FIRE was outrun.
