ARIELA, within striking distance off the inside, waited for room on the turn, moved between rivals approaching the stretch, angled to the inside, bid with a furlong to go and drew clear under steady urging. CASH CRUNCH, never far back, raced three wide leaving the second turn, challenged with a furlong to go but was no match for the winner late. MOJAVE LASS vied for the lead off the inside, stayed well to midstretch and tired. MISS NIKNAR pressed the pace three wide between rivals, steadied with a furlong to go when in tight then tired. SLEW EM BERTI, within striking distance, raced five wide on the turn and had nothing left in the drive. WHAT'S THE FUSS alternated for the lead inside and gave way in the drive. MAGIC IN THE MUSIC forced the pace, raced five wide into the turn and faded in the drive. SLUH'S GOLDEN GIRL prompted the pace, raced four wide into the turn and faded.
