


SEVEN FOUR SEVEN reserved early three wide, advanced four wide on the second turn, caught the leaders with a quarter mile to go, took over in midstretch and drew off under steady urging. MAJORITY WHIP within striking distance early off the rail, moved out four wide late on the second turn and improved her position late. LOOKING AFAR forced the pace between rivals, lost position after a half, came again to be close up with a furlong to go and held on gamely the remainder. GAL ON THE GO well placed early, angled out near the half mile marker, made a bold five wide move on the second turn, challenged approaching the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. PERSIMMON RIDGE forced the early pace four wide, moved in a bit on the backstretch while gaining a short lead, held well to midstretch and tired. SUDDENLY GONE close up early three wide, angled out to be four wide on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and tired in the drive. THERE RUNS HATTIE outrun early, angled out five wide entering the stretch and was no threat. MYSTICS BLUE ROSE vied for the lead along the inside, held on well for five furlongs and tired. WEALTHY BELONGINGS reserve early along the inside, angled out to be three wide on the second turn and was no factor. TOWN QUEEN five wide on the first turn when close up, challenged before a half, held on well to the quarter mile marker and faded. SWEETWATER PROMISE stumbled at the start and was outrun.
