MISS DUSTY vied for the lead three wide, responded to pressure in the stretch and drew clear late. REBS TEMPTRESS alternated for the lead between rivals and held on gamely in the drive. LAURA B behind the leaders, steadied midway through the turn when boxed in then lacked a late bid inside. GHAZINE outrun early along the inside, improved her position into the stretch but had no late bid. FAVORITE AGAIN within striking distance, raced in the three path on the turn and had nothing left in the drive. TAN outrun early, was no threat. PINK GOLD forwardly placed off the inside, tired in the drive. TOAST TO HENIU within striking distance, raced four wide on the turn and gave way in the stretch. SOME LUCK contested the pace from the inside and faded in the drive.
