SHARP INSULT vied for the lead along the inside, took over before a half and drew off under steady urging. STEPS five wide on the first turn when outrun, advanced inside into the second turn, angled out entering the stretch and finished willingly for the place. GLORY AND POWER outsprinted early, advanced along the inside on the second turn, reached closest to the winner after six furlong but had no late bid. WHATABULL unhurried early, lacked a closing bid. MISS FIT behind the leaders three wide, held on well to the stretch and gave way. SHE WHO HEALS outrun early, was no threat. SOOEY EXPRESS used early, forced the pace off the inside and faded. SANDTINA six wide on the first turn, stayed in that path with three furlongs to go and could not menace. GENERAL STEFFIE was no factor. PEROXIDE BLOND four wide on the first turn, stopped. DREAM ASTER (JPN) far back early, was pulled up in deep stretch.
