FOR FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$250 to enter and \$250 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Wednesday, February 6, 2008 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees). \$50,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 6th through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 121 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes at a mile or over since October 1 allowed, 2 lbs.; \$19,500 twice at a mile or over since August 1, 4 lbs.; of two races other than claiming at a mile or over in 2007-2008, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest total earnings in 2007-2008. In addition no same owner entry may start to the exclusion of a single entry. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed Wednesday, January 30, 2008 with 38 Nominations.

LA PEROUSE outrun early six wide, stayed in that path on the second turn when advancing then closed fast to be up in time. FUN LOGIC reserved early, moved up four wide on the second turn, challenged and held on gamely to miss. OUR DANCING BABE outrun early in the four path, angled in when advancing on the second turn, gained the inside midway through the second turn, came around a rival entering the stretch, challenged soon after but was outfinished. WATER GAP reserved for a half, advanced five wide on the second turn, reached a forward position with a furlong to go but lodged only a mild late bid. RAYONA outrun early, saved ground on the second turn, came off the rail for the drive but made only a mild gain. ADHRHYTHM angled out four wide on the first turn when forwardly placed, challenged before a half, stayed on well to the final quarter and tired. ELITIST within striking distance five wide, tired. DASHES N DOTS alternated for the lead three wide, saved ground on the second turn and faded. PRINCESS LAILA close up early in the four path,

held on well for six furlongs and stopped. JILL INDY PULPIT was outrun. CHACANA set the early pace off the inside and stopped.
