LUCKIE CHUCKIE close up off the rail, steadied in traffic near the three furlong marker, angled out four wide soon after, made a bold move to the lead in midstretch and drew off late. MOUNT DOLLBERG close up inside, steadied repeatedly on the backstretch, waited around the second turn then lodged a mild bid for the place. BIG PICTURE GUY vied for the lead off the rail, saved ground on the second turn and tired in the final furlong. SOLDERO within striking distance three wide, challenged on the second turn but tired in the drive. TUTANKHAMUN steadied on the first turn behind rivals, was reserved for a half, raced four wide on the second turn and could not threaten. VALLEYTAKEOVER prompted the pace four wide, held on well to the stretch and faded. RUN MARVIN RUN forced the pace in the three path and faded. NATIVE NOTEBOOK was no factor. A FOUL CLAIM BY THE TRAINER AGAINST THE RIDER OF THE WINNER FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED.
