Footnotes

POST HASTE forwardly placed four wide, challenged from that path after a half, went with SAINT'S PLAY leaving the second turn when that one ranged up on the outside, bumped with that same rival in deep stretch then was narrowly best. SAINT'S PLAY hesitated at the start, made a steady advanced after settling, challenged five wide on the second turn, bumped with the winner in deep stretch and held gamely. EGYPT outrun early, raced six wide on the second turn and improved her position while no threat. SYND reserved early along the inside, moved out a bit on the second turn when making a mild gain then had nothing left late. SEA OF STORMS vied for the lead in the four path, moved in a bit for the second turn, held on well to midstretch and tired. SOLOVEY unhurried early, moved out five wide midway through the second turn and could not menace. LAKE CHAMPLAIN angled in early, raced within striking distance off the inside and faded. CONFLICTOFINTEREST forwardly placed three wide, raced four wide midway through the second turn and gave way. MILK RIVER vied for the lead in the three path, held on well for five furlongs and faded.
