LAVENHAM set the pace off the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired. REMEMBERYOURPLACE reserved early, saved ground on the second turn, stayed on well to the stretch and gave way. QUICK IN MOTION unprepared for the start, was outrun to the stretch and rallied belatedly. EMPIRE MOON five wide on the first turn, was no threat. OH SUDANA reserved three wide, was floated six wide midway through the second turn and could not menace. TOUCH OF SUCCESS close up three wide, faded. SIMONE forwardly placed four wide, moved out a path on the second turn and faded. CHAMPAGNE JANE pressed the pace off the inside and stopped.
