FOR FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$250 to enter and \$250 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Thursday, February 10, 2011 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees). \$50,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 6th through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes at a mile or over since October 1 allowed, 2 lbs.; \$19,500 twice at a mile or over since August 1, 4 lbs.; of two races other than claiming at a mile or over in 2010-2011, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest total earnings in 2010-2011. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees.

LA GRAN BAILADORA reserved off the rail, settled with three furlongs to go, angled out a bit for the drive and closed willingly to be clear late. HUNGRY TIGRESS unhurried five wide, made a run in that path into the stretch and finished well for the place. JONMIL'S EDGE forwardly placed four wide, moved in a bit for the second turn, held on well to the stretch and tired in the final furlong. LIVE AND LOVE set a good pace off the inside, led to the final sixteenth and faltered. SWEET MIS KITTY outrun for a half, raced six wide with three furlongs to go, moved in company with the runner up to the stretch but lacked a late bid. COASTAL SOLACE within striking distance four wide, had nothing left in the stretch. WEST COURT bothered at the start, was reserved inside and never menaced. NATIVE MIZ outrun three wide, could not threaten. DANCE TO MY TUNE lost his footing at the start, steadied entering the first turn when in tight then gave way. ZONGA ZING drifted out at the start and bothered WEST COURT, raced closest to the pace for a half and faded in the final quarter.

CHAMPAGNE JANE bumped at the start, was forwardly placed three wide but stopped.
